SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

- Artists and poets are invited to submit a maximum of three (3) works.
- Acceptable art media: painting, sculpture, printmaking, fine craft, photography, mixed media, fabric art and digital art.
- Selected works will be displayed at the Confederation Centre of the Arts in the concourse from September 16 to October 10, 2010.
- **The deadline for all submissions for the Mindscapes P.E.I. Selection Committee is August 9, 2010** •
 - Please send clear photographic representation(s) of your work(s) in jpeg file format (approximate file size should be no larger than 1 MB, about 1250 pixels in width) or send in regular photographs (minimum photo size 4”x 6”).
 - **Please DO NOT send your actual artwork for the selection process. We require only photographs of your work(s) at this stage.**
 - If you are submitting poetry, please send us the text of your poem.

- **The following must accompany your submission:**
 1. Your full name and complete mailing address;
 2. Your telephone number and e-mail address (if you have an email address);
 3. Title, type of medium, and size of each piece;
 4. Your **Artist Profile:** The “Artist Profile” should be **no more than 75 words**. If your work is chosen for Mindscapes P.E.I., your “Artist Profile” will be posted next to your work during the exhibition. Please write whatever you wish about yourself: perhaps what inspired you to create your work, something about your experience of mental illness – whatever you’re comfortable sharing with the viewing audience. If are comfortable writing only a few sentences, that is fine too. There are no hard and fast rules. Just don’t exceed the 75-word limit.

PLEASE NOTE

CMHA/PEI cannot guarantee that every artist or poet who submits their work will be chosen to exhibit. It is possible we will have to limit the number of artists or poets displayed in accordance with the number of submissions we receive and available venue space.
