- Maximum size is 30"x36". 8"x10" will also be welcome. They must be easel-backed to stand on a table.
- Organizers have the right to refuse any work that does not meet the admission criteria, or exhibits signs of poor quality.
- Please include contact information in your Artist Statement if you are interested in selling your work. No sales at conference.
